



10 Ways to cut IT costs in SME and 3rd Sector organisations

- 1. Telecoms**
 - Reviewing telephony bills can reveal easy ways to save money
 - Consider using VoIP too, there are plenty of free or very cheap options that can drive down costs
- 2. Networks**
 - Reviewing WAN link bills can reveal further easy ways to save money
- 3. Maintenance**
 - Never just re-sign a maintenance agreement, always review it. A good one to start with is hardware, then move on to Microsoft.
- 4. Outsource**
 - Outsourcing can save money, but it's a double edged sword. Never undertake an IT outsourcing deal without using someone who's done it before.
- 5. Data Centres & Hosting**
 - Reviewing Data-Centre or hosting contracts that are more than a year old will most likely find savings.
- 6. Service Levels**
 - If you don't need 24/7 cover, changing to 8am-6pm Monday to Friday can make a huge difference in cost.
- 7. Printing**
 - Printing costs a lot of money particularly colour printing. Education is the key.
- 8. Training & Development**
 - Not just for IT staff, but for everyone else. Improving technical skills in your staff will reduce the cost of support and boost productive use of IT
- 9. Desktops**
 - A boost in memory usually removes the need to replace a desktop PC. Only provide laptops when they are really needed.
- 10. Virtualisation**
 - Virtualisation can reduce costs in many ways – electricity, licensing, rack-space, cooling, etc. Again, engage with an expert and savings can be made.
